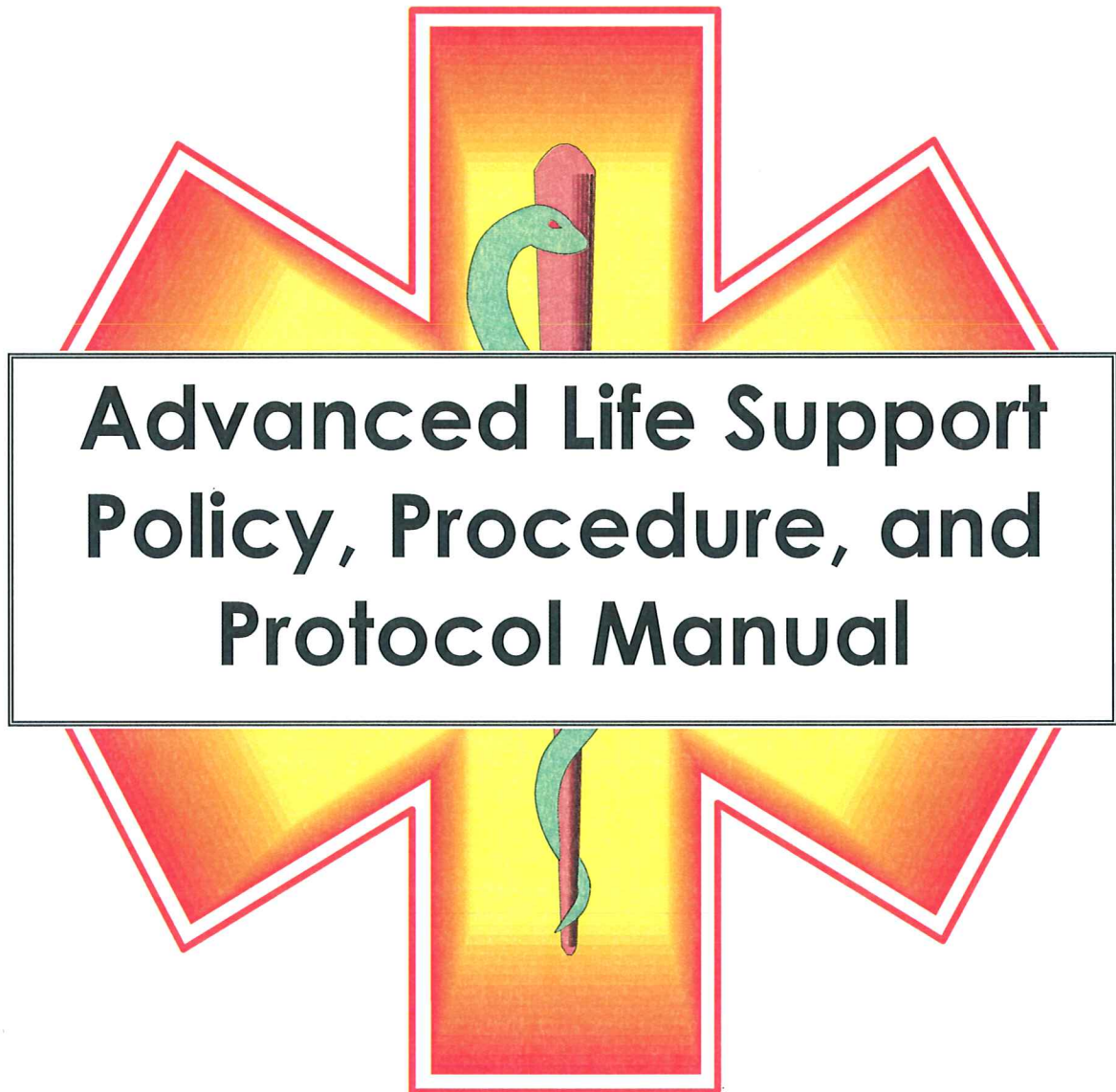

**Note:** This protocol is **only for use** on patients who have been diagnosed with congenital adrenal hyperplasia and this is confirmed by medical alert tag, patient record, family or medical staff and presenting with signs of adrenal crisis.

**Standing Orders:**

- A. Oxygen
- B. Establish IV access (Protocol III.S)
- C. Administer Hydrocortisone Sodium Succinate (Solu-Cortef) 2 mg/kg IV push, (Not to exceed 100 mg.)
- D. Begin transport ASAP
- E. Have MedCon notify receiving hospital that patient has received Stress Dose of Hydrocortisone Sodium Succinate (Solu-Cortef).

**Medical Control Options:**

- Normal saline 20cc/kg IV bolus
